

2025-2026 RaiseRight ENROLLMENT FORM

Grassfield Band Parent Association RaiseRight Rebate Program

1. Online orders for physical gift cards placed through the RaiseRight website must be submitted by 6:00PM on the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month. All check payments for these orders must be placed in the RaiseRight box, no later than the end of the school day on the 1st and 3rd Monday of each month.
2. All orders must be paid either online on the RaiseRight website (preferred) or by a check payable to GFBPA (no cash).
3. **eGift Digital Gift Cards:** if these are ordered and paid for online on the RaiseRight website, users will see them available for use in their RaiseRight account wallet immediately after purchase. Users should contact the RaiseRight help desk for any and all issues regarding delivery of the eGift Digital Gift Card.
4. If your check is returned because of non-sufficient funds (NSF), you will be charged a \$30 fee payable to GFBPA (plus the cost of the original purchase). Your RaiseRight privileges will be suspended until fees are paid to GFBPA. If more than two NSF checks are tendered on your account, GFBPA *will* limit your RaiseRight ordering privileges.
5. Upon request, GFBPA will provide a summary of each participating family's RaiseRight purchases. Summary reports are also available online through raiseright.com.
6. RaiseRight cards are purchased on your behalf and are not returnable.
7. When you pick up your RaiseRight gift cards, please verify accuracy. Your signature on the order form indicates you have received your order in its entirety. In the unlikely event you should find a discrepancy in your RaiseRight order, please contact the GFBPA RaiseRight program coordinator within 7 days.
8. RaiseRight cards are the same as cash and should be handled accordingly. The GFBPA is not responsible for gift cards that are lost, stolen or misplaced while in your possession.
9. You must sign the **WAIVER OF RESPONSIBILITY FORM** before physical gift cards will be released to your student or another party. GFBPA, the RaiseRight coordinators, and the RaiseRight coordinators' students accept no responsibility for gift cards delivered in this manner. If you do not want your gift cards released to your student, pickup options are available.
10. You must submit a **RAISERIGHT REBATE FORM annually by the due date on the form or your Raise Right Account will be disabled and your Grizzly Dollars will be donated to the Band Program. This form must be re-submitted ANNUALLY at the end of May.**
11. Family members may enroll in the GFBPA RaiseRight program on behalf of your student. Before family members may be enrolled, you must actively participate in RaiseRight by placing at least 8 orders (to ensure your understanding of the program). Family members must fill out and submit all enrollment, waiver, and annual rebate forms to GFBPA before enrollment. GFBPA will not mail physical cards to family members; physical cards must be picked up in person. If a check is returned for NSF, the BAND PARENT will be responsible for settling fees with GFBPA.
